#### **Activities of the project so far!**

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Transnational Project Meeting in Greece**

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> of October 2019, the second transnational project meeting took place in Larissa, Greece, coordinated by Jugend- & Kulturprojekt e.V. and hosted by Ke.Di.Vi.M2 Kainotomia.

Its purpose was to:

- Monitor the progress of the project by collecting the status of the project tasks from project partners and by reviewing them against the project plan.
- Discuss the completion of the PRORITY Methodology that will enable migrants and refugees to participate in social and cultural life with locals, thus deconstructing myths, prejudices and stereotypes.
- Discuss the development of the PRIORITY Toolkti/E-Toolkit, comprising of practical tools that promote integration and community-building through the arts, culture, education and sports.

- Work on the design and the content of the PRIORITY on-line hubs, the E-toolkit, the "How to Prioritize" Interactive Ebook, and the PRIORITY App.
- Finalise the programme of the upcoming 2<sup>nd</sup>
  Capacity Building Activity, that is going to take
  place in the end of October 2019, in Palermo,
  Italy.
- Discuss the dissemination activities and update the various project plans and solve any administration, management and technical issue of the project.





#### What we have recently achieved!

- The first project deliverable entitled "Research Report and Analysis of Best Practices" is ready. This output maps existing voluntary arts, sports, cultural and youth practices for community-building and youth inclusion.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> Capacity Building Activity took place in Larissa, 25-29/6/2019 in Kainotomia's facilities, during which 15 participants from the partner organisations were trained on how to successfully build a PRIORITY Hub.
- The Physical PRIORITY Community Cultural Hubs are reality! These inclusive places will host diverse cultural, artistic, social and political positions will be welcome, and which will promote creativity, openness, tolerance and diversity.

#### **Upcoming Activities!**

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Capacity Building Activity, in Palermo, Italy

From the 28<sup>th</sup> to the 30<sup>th</sup> of October 2019, 15 youth workers, teachers, sport educators, municipality workers will attend the 2<sup>nd</sup> Capacity Building Activity-CBA that will take place in Palermo Italy.



This will be an entry level, 3-day workshop that will equip the participants with certain soft and hard skills in order to be able to implement the inclusion workshops for young migrants and refugees along with the young mediator capacity building phase of PRIORITY project.

During the 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA the trainees will be work on:

- How to approach youth at risk of marginalisation. They will be asked to represent main personal and structural obstacles to youth social inclusion at local level.
- Listing the set of instruments for youth workers to identify the main risks and barriers to social inclusion of young people in the local community.
- How to motivate young people at risk of marginalisation to participate and engage: designing and offering attractive activities towards youth.
- Planning the seed: how to create peer educators and multipliers among youth at risk of marginalisation.

#### Coming next...

Our work on the project will continue:

- JKPeV, CSC Danilo Dolci, MVI, MV NGO and KAINOTOMIA will develop the content of the PRIORITY Toolkit and ASSIST will create its digital form.
- All the partners will translate the PRIORITY Research Report and Analysis of Best Practices, as well as the PRIORITY Methodology in all partners languages.
- The third Transnational Project Meeting will be held on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of May 2020 in Sassari, Sardinia, Italy.
